After Nelson's time at Honda, he led Supply Chain at Deere. During his tenure Deere became known for implementing world-class supply management processes. In 2001, those efforts were recognized when *Purchasing Magazine* awarded Deere the Medal of Professional Excellence, the purchasing industries highest award..

Three of Mr. Nelson's books, *The Purchasing Machine*, *Powered by Honda*, and *The Incredible Payback*; are widely recognized and key texts in the supply chain space.
